

**24th Annual Meeting EORS  
Bologna, 14-16 September 2016**

**POSTERS**

The poster number will be stated in the Congress final program at the pages "Posters".

The poster should be set up on Wednesday, 14 September 2016 starting from 12.00 and removed on Friday, 16 September 2016 after 15.30.

EORS 2016 considers poster presentations of equal merit to oral presentations.

Poster pitches are an exciting new opportunity to promote basic science and research and to attract delegates and enhance interaction.

The presence during the session of the presenting author is a necessary condition for publication and awards.

Poster pitch sessions are indicated on the time table on the final scientific program.

It will be allocated 2 minutes to verbally summarize the content of the poster. The presentation will be near the poster (no slide projection available). Furthermore the poster viewing with authors available at their posters for participants questions will take place during daily coffee breaks on 15 and 16 September.

Posters should be printed and the maximum size is A0 format (84 cm. x 118,90 cm) VERTICAL oriented (portrait) printed with visible characters (font not smaller than size 36). Poster board dimensions 90 cm wide x 120 cm high.

Please do not exceed these dimensions due to limited available space on the poster boards. Heading should include abstract title, author names, author affiliations and financial disclosure statement.

Location poster number and set up material will be provided.

We kindly remind you that it is strictly forbidden to fix your poster on a different poster board from the one previously assigned (for any need please contact the Registration Desk).

The Organizing Secretariat is not responsible for those posters that are not removed on time.

Poster area will be freely accessible during all the meeting time.
